

**AWARDS INFORMATION FOR 2006**  
(Patches & Trophies)

Each March the Obedience Training Club of Greater Lansing recognizes and honors the accomplishments and dedicated labors of its members of the previous year with a number of awards. An explanation of those awards, and of how they may be earned is included in this pamphlet.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

Patches and trophies are awarded only to members in good standing of the Obedience Training Club of Greater Lansing (hereinafter referred to as the Club) who became a member and attended at least one club meeting as a member no later than December 2006, except as noted. In order to receive any of these awards, the applicant must have:

1. Attended at least one regular meeting of the Club as a member **AND** worked in some capacity during at least two organized events held by the Club or the BACKYARD 200 organization during 2006;

**OR**

2. Worked in some capacity during at least three organized events held by the Club or BACKYARD 200 during 2006.

One patch per dog, per award, will be awarded at no charge. Club back patches cost \$5, to be included with the application form. Additional patches of the same designation may be purchased at a cost of \$2 each, provided the money is included with the member's award application. Additional title patches and patches for titles earned before becoming a member may be purchased for \$2.00, providing the club has an available inventory.

**DEADLINES AND QUESTIONS**

All patches and trophies earned during each calendar year (January 1 - December 31) must be applied for by the member who owns the dog. (Ownership in all cases includes co-ownerships.) If two or more club members share ownership of a dog, 2nd, etc. patches must be paid for and all owners will be listed in the program.

**The deadline for applications will be Thursday, February 15.** Applications should be submitted to the Awards Committee c/o **Pam Moore, 12100 Berryville Road, Rives Junction, MI, 49277-9638.** The committee takes NO responsibility for applications left in the office at the Training Center, although we will make every effort to pick them up from there. Awards will be presented at a banquet during the March meeting of the Club.

**SPECIAL SERVICE AWARDS**

Recognition of one or two big-hearted Club members who provide service to the Club and their fellow members far above and beyond the "minimum requirements", sometimes to the detriment of their own dog's training.

Other accomplishments: For areas of achievement where patches are not available a listing is provided on the patch application, these will be printed in the awards program.

**OWNERSHIP:** The "owner" of a dog is considered the owner of record at the time that a title is awarded by the awarding organization. If ownership is being transferred the date of transfer on the accepted transfer form will be used.
